MOR CHANCES was outrun for a half, swung five wide splitting horses at the quarter pole and unleashed a strong late run to get up in the late stages. PENNINGTON was unhurried early, rallied five wide, gained a clear lead in midstretch and yielded late. GOLD VENDETTA circled six wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. LIVIN LARGE raced in traffic between horses into midstretch and lacked a late response. MR. VEGAS saved ground, steadied inside on the turn, lacked room in traffic in midstretch and failed to threaten thereafter. GOODANDACCEPTABLE pressed three wide to the turn and tired. STRONG IMPACT forced the pace from outside for a half, lodged a bid in upper stretch and gave way. MINE OVER MATTER was never a factor. CAYO HUESO dueled on the rail and faltered on the turn.
