**Footnotes**

RICORIATOA away well at the start, settled into the pocket, contently tracked the front runner from there down the backstretch and around the turn, was forced to be kept on hold briefly, awaiting options as the field headed for the quarter pole, found the necessary daylight just past that station and angled out sharply for it, was set down to a hard drive after completing the maneuver, closed in readily on the leader, drew abreast in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, took over a few strides later and edged away, under a vigorous hand ride. THE ZIPSTER shot to the front leaving the starting gate, was guided over to the rail and put to a good hold, continued along on the lead, unasked for a response until the three-sixteenths pole, was released from the previous hold with the top one starting to bear down, emerged from the furlong grounds still maintaining a comfortable advantage, reached the sixteenth pole on nearly even terms with the winner, lost contact shortly thereafter but dug in well to preserve the place. MASALA raced three wide around the turn and rallied willingly to grab the show. LION ATTACK bumped soundly at the break, gave chase between rivals on the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. THE ELEVATOR checked hard after being slammed into by LION ATTACK at the start, recovered, was put to hand encouragement and rushed up, continued to march forward from the three path during the run around the bend, still loomed a prominent factor at the quarter pole but soon flattened out. EASY GALLOP broke inward, bumping hard with LION ATTACK and carrying that opponent into THE ELEVATOR, assumed a forward position, was coaxed along stalking the pacesetter from the two path, steadily tired after completing a half.
