GIMME CREDIT left well and quickly settled along the inside, loosely tracked the leader during the opening stages, began to narrow the gap departing the backstretch, slipped off the inside midway on the far turn, continued to keep pace under a bit of coaxing, was forced to be kept on hold, caught behind and amongst rivals from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, slithered outward ever so slightly just after entering upper stretch, bumped with ALLTIFFEDOFF, appeared to get clipped behind by the aforementioned rival in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, forged on ahead, unshaken by either incident, struck the front with an eighth to go and drew clear under a brisk hand ride. WESTSIDE CORRAL saved ground until the quarter pole, gradually worked his way to the center of the course and displayed a good kick en route for the place. BISHOP OF NOLA quickly established command, set the pace from the inside, loosely-contested and with the rider applying rating tactics, was asked for a response once the pressure intensified during the initial portion of the stretch run, held his ground until midstretch before weakening into the third slot. MIDNIGHT BILLY underwent a three wide pursuit, drifting inward ever so slightly, as the winner was simultaneously inching his way to the outside, putting ALLTIFFEDOFF in the unfortunate situation of being wedged in tight quarters between rivals, bumped with that one, remained a stretch threat until the furlong marker before flattening out a bit. MR. ENRICO four wide in upper stretch, lacked the needed response. ALLTIFFEDOFF was rated prompted the pacesetter from the outside for nearly three-quarters, got bumped from both sides after being placed in tight quarters in upper stretch, bobbed after clipping heels a couple of strides later and failed to pick up any real interest thereafter.
