BOSTON POP assumed a forward position soon after the start, patiently tracked the front runners from the outside, crept up towards that pair leaving the five-sixteenths pole and had the rider tap the brakes, was maneuvered outward slightly as MAGIC JAZZ began to back away, was asked for a response for the initial time, well past the three-sixteenths pole, reached the eighth pole only heads apart with the runner up, battled on even terms during the upcoming sixteenth, grabbed the front and edged away. DECCAN ODYSSEY along the inside, sparred with MAGIC JAZZ during the opening half, had no sooner put that opponent away when the top one arrived on the scene, dug in stubbornly as the pair raced as a team, was shaken off with about a sixteenth to go, but continued on gamely to the end for the place. YESTERDAY'S STORY saved ground around the turn, was put to a prolonged drive but proved no match for the top twosome. RETURN THE GIFTS three wide, lacked the necessary stretch response. LOOK TO THE FUTURE had no rally. COLD SHOT raced along the outside and was never a threat. FIND THE STASH displayed green action for most of the way down the backstretch, failed to reach a contending position. MAGIC JAZZ disputed the pace from the outside for a half and gave way.
