Footnotes

MYSTIC CITY vied for the lead along the inside, raced in tandem with the runner up for nearly three-quarters, was asked for some run leaving the five-sixteenths pole as WHO IS LADY began to edge clear, cut the corner under encouragement and with a full head of steam, gained control as the rider of WHO IS LADY was preoccupied with, and absolutely necessarily so, with the antics of the rider less horse, opened up a length advantage in the flash of an eye, felt pressure from the runner up nearing the eighth pole, but spurted away again, once more as the runner up was forced to hesitate, with the pesky loose horse looming dangerously to that opponent's outside, dug in thereafter under a drive to preserve the decision. WHO IS LADY sparred with the top one from the outside, with only a narrow margin separating the pair for almost six furlongs, was starting to edge away with a clear advantage approaching the quarter pole, when the rider less rival arrived on the scene, poised directly to the outside, hesitated, and was forced to remain unleashed, lost momentum and the lead to the top one as a result, got going again and had just reached the winner's hind quarters, when forced to be taken back in hand, when bothered by the loose opponent a second time, attempted to re rally, but failed to regain her best stride, having to settle for the place in a luckless journey. TUTTI VA BENE well placed along the inside, came up empty for the stretch drive. FREEDOM RINGS was forced to check on the backstretch to avoid contact with MS STILLETO, raced along the outside and finished willingly to secure the last major award. HIGH CRY was taken in hand and maneuvered to the inside to avoid the fallen jockey down the backstretch, commenced a mild rally five wide at the head of the stretch. UPPER EAST SIDER perched three wide off an ongoing pace dispute, had no kick. STARJETTA was forced to steady in tight quarters in the chute, acted rank racing amongst rivals after entering the backstretch, jostled with MS STILLETO, bumping several times with that foe, had just gone by when clipped from behind by that one, was a forward factor for three-quarters and tired. MS STILLETO traded bumps with a rank STARJETTA early down the backstretch, clipped that one's heels, stumbled and lost the rider as a result. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident on the backstretch before the result was declared

official.
