LT. JOHN stalked the front runners from the outside, leading the second flight down the backstretch, was guided over into the three path for the run around the far turn and steadily advanced into contention, entered the stretch and took off in earnest, sparred with the second place finisher during the later stages of the run through the furlongs before poking head down in front at the eighth pole, with several others still in hot pursuit, couldn't shake off the runner up as the two continued to engage in a spirited head to head battle the rest of the way, showed gameness refusing to yield to earn the decision. LOVE SHACK (IRE) left well and worked his way to the lead before leaving the first turn, had EAST INDIES draw alongside upon entering the backstretch, vied with that opponent, while kept at a slight distance from off the inside, began to edge away nearing the half mile pole, felt the others closing in and although still in possession of a comfortable advantage, was asked for run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, got hooked in a stretch duel with the winner soon after turning for home, fell back by the narrowest of margins with an eighth to go, battled back hard but failed to re gain. ELDER SKATESMAN lumbered along taking the inside route on the first turn, vacated the premises and swung outward early on the backstretch, picked up interest at the half mile pole and steadily advanced, under some encouragement, from the three path into contention, sustained the momentum turning for home, finishing with willingness to secure the show. SLAMM'N LOU settled into midpack after the start, took the inside route around the far turn, was angled outward, appeared to be moving well during the earliest portion of the stretch, had the bid stalled and was taken hold, forced to bide time behind rivals from upper stretch until just past the

eighth pole, tipped a bit wider, splitting rivals in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, flashed some interest in the last seventy yards, missing out on the show. CLEAR OUT along the inside, had no rally. R J HOPE placed five wide at the head of the stretch, had no response. GAMBLIN FEVER off a beat slowly, raced near the back of the field, swung four wide into the stretch, had no offering to render. LAUNCH N RELAUNCH stumbled at the start, made a quick along the rail and was outrun thereafter. EAST INDIES looped the field after breaking from the outermost stall and rushed up to contest the pace, argued for command for just under a half then retreated. SAME OLD WISH was through after completing three-quarters. .
