### Footnotes

ISN'T HE PERFECT unhurried in the early going, shifted to the rail at the nine-sixteenths, saved ground throughout the bend coming under urging to close in from the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the lane, rallied into prominence with an eighth to go, was presented a seam down along the rail, seized the opportunity to go on through, took over from the stubborn leader just past the sixteenth pole and edged away under a drive. MYSTICISM hustled from the gate, dueled just off the inside through solid fractions, was able to shake off his main rival up front at the quarter pole, was placed to a drive after straightening away, drifted off the rail in the vicinity of the eighth pole under left handed encouragement, fought on getting displaced with a sixteenth to go when weakening late on. THOSE WER THE DAYS reserved off the pace, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole while racing three wide, continued three wide turning for home after gaining on the front, was poised in contention with an eighth to go but could make no further late headway in the final furlong. R KING OF THE ROAD away alertly, dueled from the three path down the backside before shifting in one path around the turn, was pushed along from the five-sixteenths in the midst of getting shaken off by his main speed rival, remained prominent through to the eighth pole and weakened thereafter.
