Footnotes

GITCHEE GOOMIE the last to pop out of the starting gate, was content to bring up the rear for nearly a half, got placed in the three path coming to the end of the backstretch and unleashed a run around the far turn that secured her a good striking position by the quarter pole, rider atop with a snug hold on the reins all the while, was tipped out just a bit more for the stretch drive, went on slightly more down the road before being called upon, responded with eagerness, scooting by the front runners to emerge from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage, dug in with good determination in the late stages to stave off the runner up. HESSONITE was well reserved under a good hold for the opening three-quarters, left the five-sixteenths marker, forced to bide time while placed between rivals, entered the stretch with no improvement in the situation, finally gained access to the outside nearing the end of the run through the furlong grounds once the winner, having settled into her best stride by this juncture, went on to take command, altered course to the outside and was given her cue, closed in well, but belatedly and had to settle for the place. ROGUE'S JEWEL loosely stalked the pacesetter from the outside, picked up the pace and made a bid coming to the quarter pole, kept up the pursuit for next furlong, then fell back into the show when unable to keep pace with the top twosome. LISA JEAN rode the rail until the quarter pole, displayed a mild kick en route for the last major check. MYSTIC CITY acted up while skittish in the gate, was backed out, remounted and reloaded, proceeded to come away with no apparent mishap, tracked the front runners while taking the inside route and faltered. FRIVOLOUS BUCK underwent a three wide journey, folded. RISKY RACHEL broke on top and had control before reaching the backstretch, set moderate fractions, rated along on the inside and only mildly pressed by the closest pursuers, was put to the test arriving at the quarter pole and got asked for a response, offered some resistance before yielding a short distance from the furlong marker, then retreated.
