EASTWOOD forwardly placed four wide within range of the front, came under coaxing three furlongs out, swung five wide under a drive into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, edged away to the wire kept to task. SLIVER AND ONIONS just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement at the three-eighths, angled six wide at the quarter pole as the field stacked up, kicked on belatedly inside the final sixteenth offering up a good finish for the place. MR. O'LEARY broke in at the start filling the gap left when ABLE BAKER CHARLIE broke awkwardly inside, raced three wide in pursuit of the front urged from three furlongs out, took narrow command swinging four wide for home, dug in kicking on and was displaced near the eighth pole, kept on with good energy through to the wire being outfinished late for the place honors. WELTER WEIGHT four wide in mid pack, came under urging five wide at the midway point on the turn, continued five wide for home, offered up a mild kick in the late stages for the last major share. GOLDEN LAD two to three wide towards the rear a bit green early on, came under a ride midway on the turn, angled five wide for home in behind other rivals, improved position by mostly tired foes in the late stages with mild energy. FIRST BEACH hesitated at the start getting off half a beat slow, settled two to three wide towards the rear, came under urging shifted four wide at the seven-sixteenths, angled seven wide in upper stretch and passed tired rivals in the stretch. LOCHTE three wide in mid pack, got set down at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild bid to the furlong grounds then flattened out in the final furlong. BOCELLI chased two to three wide within aim, angled four wide for home under a drive and weakened in the final eighth. ABLE BAKER CHARLIE broke awkwardly at the start then was outrun in the early going, came under prolonged urging from the seven-sixteenths saving

ground in the turn, steadied briefly at the quarter pole, improved position late while making no impact. DEADICATED DEAL just off the inside in mid pack, was ridden along from midway on the turn and made no impact. LET THE CAT OUT saved ground towards the rear, got asked at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide for home and offered no serious response. HIGH FIVE AGAIN prompted the pace from just off the inside, was put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, remained prominent to the quarter pole then steadily gave way. GREEN GRATTO urged on the pace inside under pressure, got headed midway on the turn, kept on to cut the corner into the stretch then faltered in the drive.
