BIG BLUE KITTEN established control soon after the start, showed the way, well rated along the inside and under the watchful of the runner up, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, had LONDON LANE draw up to his hind quarters nearing the end of the run around the far turn, turned for home, still under a good hold, as was the previously mentioned opponent, was finally let loose and left the three-sixteenths pole once more holding a good length advantage, had that lead sawed in half during the upcoming sixteenth, remained under a strong drive as the runner up continued chip away at his edge stride by stride, but dug in tenaciously to the bitter end to earn the decision. LONDON LANE patiently prompted the leader from the outside, ranged up to that one nearing the five-sixteenths pole, continued to bide time until three-sixteenths pole, battled hard as he chiseled away at the top one's advantage, only to fall a nose shy at the wire, in a valiant effort nonetheless. PLEAD within range along the outside, commenced to rally from the five path at the head of the stretch, but proved no match for the top twosome. LONGHAMMER saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the necessary stretch response. FRESHMAN DORM three wide on the opening bend, found room to tuck a bit closer to the inside down the backstretch, sat reserved, was urged three wide for the stretch drive and flattened out. ELEVEN FINAL FOURS was steadied along at several points during the opening stages, acting rankly, pulling against the bit, and apparently slow to rate kindly, settled down and took the inside route, angled off the rail at the quarter pole, weakened during the last eighth. MYSTIC FEVER failed to reach contention off a ground-saving journey. TRUE LINNET three wide around the far turn, tired.
