ELTHEEB settled into midpack soon after the start, was lightly coaxed along while stalking the front runners down the backstretch, placed near the two path, was given a bit more rein nearing the half mile pole and picked up the interest, split rivals at the midway point, reached the last two remaining opponents up ahead to join them in combat, fought for the lead between them from the five-sixteenths marker until upper stretch, shook free nearing the eighth pole and arrived at that station with a clear advantage, edged away, kept to the task at hand. GOSPEL LESSON chased the pacesetter three wide, closed in on that rival upon reaching the turn, was the outermost of three contesting for command for about a furlong, commencing that action in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, got shaken off during the latter stages of the run through the furlong grounds, having drifting out briefly, resumed a straighter course with the aid of some right handed stick work and held well for second. HILL CROSSING contently prompted the early leader, parked along the outside just off that rival's hind quarters, moved up to increase the pressure nearing the half mile pole and arrived at that station head to head, soon went by, needing little encouragement to do so, and was taken closer over to the rail, got asked for run as a spirited tussle started with the first two finishers, remained in the fight until upper stretch before backing away. MACHO MUCHACHO saved ground to no avail. CREPE AU SUCRE walked out of the starting gate, raced three wide on the turn, and failed to menace. MARQUET REBEL rated near the inside for the opening half, got overhauled shortly past the half mile pole. FRENCH TRANSITION raced along the outside and tired. STUD MUFFIN departed the backstretch from the three path, was asked to pick it up at the three-eighths pole, failed to offer any response.
