Footnotes

EL ARQUERO gave chase from the outside, was already under encouragement angling three wide into the stretch, gained readily on the leader during the run through the furlong grounds, drew even at the sixteenth pole, quickly took over and kicked clear, crossing the wire, hand urged. WINDAFULL came in slightly at the start, continued in the direction of the rail and tucked along the inside, vied during the initial stages with LEMON PEEL tagging along, showed the way thereafter only loosely pressed once that opponent drifted well out in the middle of the course down the backstretch, got asked for run leading the field into the stretch, arrived at the furlong marker still in front but with the winner looming a major danger to the outside, relinquished with about a sixteenth to go, held well though for the place. MR COWBOY underwent a three wide journey, had the rider scan back for any potential threats for the show award leaving the sixteenth pole and finding none in sight, finished the final seventy yards under light urging. WIN FOR THE ZIPPER chased outside, remained a prominent factor to midstretch before backing away. EASY STREET off a beat slowly, advanced steadily into midpack, slipped off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. BARNARDS GALAXY raced three to four wide, failed to reach a contending position.

SELJUK had a wide journey, was in the four path at the midway point on the turn, made no significant headway on the front runners. JACOB'S DREAM took the overland route no the full turn, had no rally. FIVE FREEDOMS urged cutting the corner into the lane, was outrun. JULIA'S HERO faded off a ground-saving journey. LEMON PEEL contested the pace for much of the opening quarter, drifted out steadily after entering the backstretch, remained well off the rail the rest of the way and stopped.
