Footnotes

FONTLEY (GB) secured the pocket before leaving the opening bend, rated willingly while tracking the front runners in the initial stages, was lightly coaxed as the field neared the quarter pole, found room and was eased into the two path entering the stretch, went onward several strides before angling back sharply in the direction of a newly-created passageway along the rail, picked up speed when given her cue, slipped through to grab the advantage in midstretch, edged away, crossing the finish line under a primarily brisk hand ride. LA CLOCHE rode the rail for over three-quarters, was angled into the three path swinging into upper stretch, displayed a good kick en route for the place. BLUE MAIDEN (GB) rated in midpack from off the inside for six furlongs, commenced her stretch run from the three path at the head of the stretch, finished willingly to secure the show. SALARY DRIVE broke well and quickly assumed a forward position, stalked the pacesetter from the two path, applying only mild pressure down the backstretch, drew alongside the leader upon reaching the far turn to crank it up a bit, raced as a team with SURE ROUTE, with the pilots of both mounts keeping something in reserve for the stretch drive, got called upon entering the stretch and was out finished. SURE ROUTE (GB) was hand urged to clear the field and take charge early, was put to a firm hold once safely on the lead, cut the pace, well rated and facing no real resistance until the half mile pole, raced around the far turn with SALARY DIVE latched on to her for most of the way around it, was switched over to a drive at the quarter pole, drifted out slightly just past the top of the lane, creating just enough of an opening for the eventual winner, surrendered to that opponent shortly afterwards, and weakened steadily thereafter. PRIZE CATCH three wide entering the second turn, was four wide departing it, had no stretch response. LITTLE OFTEN ANNI three wide on both turns, folded.
