BUFFUM well rated while three wide in close range of the front, was lightly coaxed at the five-sixteenths pole, ranged up to confront the leader at the top of the lane, took over after straightening away, was roused near the three-sixteenths and drew clear under a drive to the wire. STAR OF NEW YORK unhurried early on, made a three wide middle move in the turn from the three-eighths pole, swung four wide at the quarter pole, proved no match for the top one while digging in to win the battle for place honors. BLACK N BEAUTY reserved off the pace, raced three wide through the turn coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung widest of all five wide in upper stretch, kicked on with good energy down the center of the lane en route to garnering the show. STAR HARBOUR set a prompted pace inside while in hand, was let out at the quarter pole in response to being confronted by the eventual winner, got displaced after straightening away, remained in contention through to the end before weakening on late while earning the last major share. GALLANT FIELDS unhurried at the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the nine-sixteenths, shifted to the rail nearing the seven-sixteenths, was in the thick of the place battle late on but was out kicked while down along the inside. YA GOTTA HAVE SOUL sat inside in reserve until the five-sixteenths, angled just off the rail turning for home and offered no response. SIMBA'S STORY prompted the pace from the two path, came under urging to keep pace at the three-eighths, lost ground and position steadily thereafter while fading.
