Footnotes

YANKEE VICTOR flashed good speed from the outside while well in hand, took over leaving the backstretch, responded when roused turning for home and drew well clear under a drive. HONEST LADY was outrun along the inside early on, came wide entering the stretch and finished gamely from the far outside to earn the place award. SIR BEAR was urged along outside on the backstretch, put in a four wide run on the turn and stayed on well to the finish. BIG JAG raced close up early, put in a three wide run approaching the stretch but lacked a solid finishing kick. LIBERTY GOLD was hustled along early, raced between rivals on the turn, came to the inside for the drive and had no rally. RICHTER SCALE raced with the pace while in hand, tried the winner entering the stretch, could not get to that rival and faded in the drive. WESTERN EXPRESSION raced close up inside while in hand and had no response when roused for the drive. STRAIGHT MAN quickly showed in front, showed good speed for a half mile and tired along the inside on the turn.
