STAKES Jaipur S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three-year-olds, 119 lbs., Older, 124 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of \$50,000 on the turf since October 1, 2004 allowed 2 lbs.; four races on the turf, 4 lbs.; \$40,000 in 2004-05; or three races on the turf, 6 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of \$45,000 on the dirt in 2005 allowed 2 lbs.; such a race in 2004; or \$33,000 twice on the dirt in 2005, 4 lbs.; four races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, May 14, 2005 with 36 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Seven Furlongs on the main track.).

ECCLESIASTIC raced in hand along the inside while in hand, advanced three wide approaching the stretch, responded when roused, dug in determinedly outside and prevailed after a long drive. OLD FORESTER raced in hand outside, rallied four wide on the turn and dug in gamely along the inside in the stretch. GULCH APPROVAL quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. TRADE FAIR (GB) raced close up outside, put in a three wide run while between rivals nearing the stretch and tired in the final furlong. SEEKING THE GLORY chased the pace from the outside and had no response when roused. THUNDER TOUCH dropped back early, raced inside and tired. BLAKELOCK chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
