CLOSE RANGE sprinted clear inside, shook loose on the turn and drew away under good handling. MYSTIC ERA steadied turn, swung wide, up for second. MAGGIE'S PRINCE was reserved early, steadied in traffic on the turn, swung wide and closed late to narrowly gain the place. DA TROUBLE chased the winner from outside into upper stretch and weakened. MOUNT KARAKORUM clipped heels and stumbled between horses on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. TERROX checked at the start and was never close thereafter. ELI'S COMIN saved ground for a half, steadied in tight at the three-sixteenths pole and lacked a further response. MAXIMUS PROSPECTOR showed speed for a half and gave way.
