Footnotes

PARC DES PRINCES (BRZ) tracked the front runners taking the inside route, turned for home under a good hold and with nowhere to go, was basically kept on hold until the eighth pole, abandoning two previous, but brief, attempts to split rivals through a vacillating opening, had that lane open up for good coming to the eighth pole, burst through with good energy en route to taking over the lead, then dug in with good determination to just hold on. GIOPI (IRE) rode the rail, availed of the opportunity to angle three just past the the quarter pole and came home with a good kick to garner place honors. FINE FLYER stalked the pacesetter three wide to the top of the stretch, got called upon and fought his way to a narrow advantage after completing the run through the furlong grounds, had it snatched away late by the top one but continued on with good energy for third. LITTLE DOVEFEATHER off the inside, finished well. BIG POLK A DOT three wide around the turn, commenced to rally in earnest considerably wider at the head of the stretch and improved position willingly. NO QUESTIONS between rivals, lacked the necessary stretch response. COUNT CATAMOUNT rated along the inside for six furlongs, faltered. FLEET APPEAL saved ground, was asked for run on the turn and came up empty. PAVORATTI'S SOUL prompted the pacesetter from the outside for three-quarters, folded.
