GITCHEE GOOMIE sat well reserved in midpack under a good hold, continued to bide time until the quarter pole, tipped into four path turning for home and swung into action, closed with good energy down the center of the course, drew on even terms with PARAIBA with a sixteenth to go, grabbed away the lead and edged clear, under some hand encouragement to the wire. PARAIBA contently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, continued along on the same scenario for the opening six furlongs, got called upon and took a run at the pacesetter, left the furlong grounds the clear leader, held the advantage for an additional sixteenth of a mile before relinquishing to the top one, but continued onward with good courage to garner place honors. CHORUS MUSIC along the inside, steadied off heels shortly after departing the chute, rode the rail the rest of the way down the backstretch and around the turn, angled outward slightly to split rivals at the sixteenth pole and rallied mildly to secure the show. AKILINA under a good hold tracking the pacesetter from the inside, lacked the necessary stretch response. FRIVOLOUS BUCK lunged at the break, raced three wide around the turn and had no rally. EXCLUSIVE SCHEME off last, split rivals under her own power and established control before leaving the chute, was rated on the inside, with the runner up keeping a watchful eye on her, was let out in upper stretch once the pressure intensified, tired steadily during the last eighth.
