BETSY BLUE EYES raced with the pace while well in hand, responded when roused for the drive and drew clear under steady pressure. QUIET CALLER set the pace along the inside and stayed on well in the stretch. NEW YORK RAINBOW, rated along outside, lacked a rally. RAY OF HAPPINESS, rated along outside, posed no real threat with a mild rally outside. STONE ENDS, rated along between rivals, was not a threat. BIRDIE'S SISTER, wrestled back inside, was never a factor during the running. WATRALS TWELVBELOW was rated along inside and tired. SPORTS AUTHORITY raced wide throughout.
