OPEN SESAME was hustled to the front, set the pace, responded when joined from the inside by WILD SUMMER leaving the backstretch, dug in resolutely in the stretch and bested that rival after a prolonged drive. WILD SUMMER showed speed along the inside, contested the pace and fought it out gamely on the rail. COUNTRY BE GOLD was outrun early, rallied along the inside on the turn, angled out into the stretch and lacked a solid finishing kick. VOLPONI raced close up while four wide and had no response when roused. YANKEE DOODLE BOY raced wide and had no rally. POLISH MINER chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. TODDLER raced inside and tired.
