GIVE AND TAKE raced close up outside, rallied four wide on the turn and stayed on gamely to the wire. FOLLOW BETSY contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. CITY CELEBRATIONS raced five wide and tired in the stretch. TRULY A LEGEND contested the pace while three wide and tired. ROSES FOR RUBY was bumped after the start, raced wide and tired. INDY FIVE HUNDRED was bumped after the start, contested the pace along the inside and tired.
