TIZWAY broke alertly and assumed a good forward position, sat perched just off the leader's hind quarters, was placed to be two wide approaching the turn and drew alongside TACKLEBERRY, raced on even terms with that opponent until the quarter pole, was set to a vigorous ride and spurted away from the competition, emerged from the furlong grounds holding a commanding lead, and safely maintained it, being kept to the task at hand. RODMAN sat reserved towards the two path for nearly three-quarters, was given some rein and picked up speed nearing the end of the turn, entered the stretch full of momentum, angled back towards the inside for better racing clearance soon after settling into upper stretch, being taken in hand to avoid contact with another rival, continued to forge on ahead finishing with good courage to be second best. CAIXA ELETRONICA stalked from the outside, was asked for run leaving midpoint on the turn, got out finished. AIKENITE raced well off the inside, came under a drive by the three-eighths pole, spun wide into the stretch, continued his rally from the five path at the top of the lane, and improved position by mainly weak and tired ones to garner the last major share. HAYNESFIELD fractious during the post parade, proceeded to come away in good order, being among the first few breakers, took up position near the front and stalked the front runners under a snug hold, was released from it about midway on the backstretch, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, being coaxed along to keep pace, bid nearing the quarter pole, but wasn't up to the task at hand. STORMY'S MAJESTY bobbed at the start, recovered quickly and moved up into the pocket, contently tracked the front runners from there, remained on hold, awaiting options headed for the stretch, got called upon after entering the lane but failed to fire. SOARING EMPIRE cut the corner under encouragement, launched a mild bid from the inside until midstretch before flattening out. IBBOYEE stumbled at the start, raced off the inside, most of the way between rivals during the initial six furlongs, swung six wide for the stretch, losing ground and momentum as a result, was set to a full drive after being straightened away but made little headway. TACKLEBERRY broke running, vied for the lead, slightly off the inside down the backstretch, with the winner applying pressure from the outside all the while, was guided over to the rail at the half mile pole, raced as a team with the top one until the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. YAWANNA TWIST between rivals, folded.

KENSEI three wide departing the backstretch, came under a prolonged drive and tired.
