KING ROCK took up residence in the pocket, contently tracked the front runners, availed of an opportunity to vacate the premises nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for some run and turned three wide into the stretch, rallied with good energy down the lane, collared the leader and kicked clear, driving. CORONATION DAY pressed the leader from the outside, made a successful bid for the lead that commenced from the quarter pole, dug in with good determination once the winner made his presence felt, yielded but continued on well to procure the place. NOBODY LIKE MIKE was fractious before the start, delaying the race about eight minutes, proceeded to come out of the starting gate in good order, stalked the leader from midpack along the outside, was roused entering the stretch and finished willingly down the outside of the strip en route for the show. DEPUTY'S CITIZEN saved ground around the turn and rallied. IRON DANCER along the inside, flattened out. JET TO CLASSICS set the pace from the inside and faltered. TIGER WILLIE underwent a three wide pursuit and folded. SEEKING ANITA raced along the outside and was outrun. MIDNIGHT MASS appeared to take several bad steps down the backstretch, was taken in hand, taken over to the far outside, and eased.
