ALCANUDANCE away alertly, was soon joined by KATSKILL BAY, dueled with that one throughout, fell a head or so behind after departing the backstretch, refused to go away, continuing the fight from the rail during the run around the bend, turned for home remaining on nearly even terms with the runner up, inched away during the ensuing furlong, then dug in under good handling the rest of the way to gamely preserve the decision. KATSKILL BAY got hooked up in a speed duel with the top one almost from the get-go, battled from the two path only heads apart for the opening half, grabbed the slimmest of advantages early on the turn and stubbornly clung to it until upper stretch, was shaken off before reaching the eighth pole, held on with good determination thereafter to fend off THE PRINCE to protect the place. THE PRINCE raced along the outside, was coaxed along to keep pace with the embattled pair during a lively opening half, was put to much stronger encouragement just past the quarter pole and got out finished. AFRICAN KING three wide departing the backstretch, ranged up to the duelers, issued a brief challenge at the five-sixteenths pole but soon flattened out. MISSILE MOTOR tracked the pace dispute while taking the inside route, was urged along, yet lost ground on the turn, angled three wide into upper stretch, was called upon and failed to fire. COGNITO three wide at the half mile pole, was no factor. COALTOWN LEGEND between rivals on the turn, was outrun.
