Footnotes

IM A QUICKIE away in good order, assumed a forward position, sat poised in the three path, just off the leader's hind quarters, pounced upon that opponent when ready at the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home, holding a clear edge, was set down to a hard drive at the three-sixteenths pole, emerged from the furlong grounds with his biggest lead, then dug in with determination to fend off the sole stretch threat to hold sway. DRINK AT LAST CALL well rated under a good hold along the inside early, left the rail to grab an available two path at the half mile pole, gradually moved towards the front runners, continued to make progress around the turn, having now been placed three wide by the five-sixteenths pole, spun from there under encouragement into the stretch, rallied willingly to garner place honors. MR. HADIF established the lead soon after the start, cut the pace, from the two path and under the watchful eye of the top one, had no answer when that foe issued his challenge for command, tired steadily thereafter. STYLISH FELLA lunged at the break, then was taken in hand and sharply pulled off the nearest rival to avoid making contact, settled down and rode the rail, angled outward just past the quarter pole, but failed to fire. MIAMI HAMMER raced along the outside, was urged on the turn, failed to reach a contending position. JELLO SHOT strung out four wide at the half mile pole, folded. MOUNT KARAKORUM raced three wide around the turn, for a time between rivals, ducked to the rail coming to the quarter pole and faded.
