UP ABOVE moved up to the front soon after the start, sparred briefly with JOLI'S HERO before edging away from that opponent under his own courage, after completing a quarter, was settled into the two path for the run around the bend, rated kindly with the rider sitting atop with a firm grip on the reins, drew clear from more energetically-handled rivals late on the turn, was put to hand encouragement upon arriving at the three-sixteenths pole, held sway under intermittent hand rousing during the final sixteenth. GYPSY WARRIOR always inside, was coaxed along on turn, attempting to keep pace, engaged in a spirited tussle with BUDDY RED down the lane, winning the battle for the place. BUDDY RED was steadied after ducking inward sharply at the start, got put back on stride and moved up taking the inside route, was eased outward coming to the half mile pole, raced widest of all around the turn, was put to a prolonged drive, got out finished. KEYALY bumped after the start, raced near the back of the pack for nearly a half, approached the quarter pole, having already been asked for run, entered the stretch four wide, had no solid closing punch to deliver. SPENCERIFIC saved ground, gradually four wide into upper stretch, had no response. JOLI'S HERO bumped with KEYALY after the start, was three wide, sparred briefly with the winner, backed away and was through after completing a half. WARRIOR FROM ABOVE had no rally.
