EXCHANGE FUNDS underwent a three wide pursuit, turned for home, the widest of a threesome closely-bunched, edged clear of them when let out in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, then held sway, being kept busy to the end. CHRISTINA D'ORO wedged tightly amongst rivals, grudgingly took the inside route around the bend, found space and was eased into the two path around the five-sixteenths pole, maintained position as best as possible under some coaxing, entered the stretch and was almost immediately set down to a drive, finished willingly to take the place. SOTIQUE was unhurried for nearly a half while saving ground, turned for home still near the rail and was asked for run, was taken hold and maneuvered past a tiring rival coming to the three-sixteenths pole, found his best stride soon afterwards and came home with good energy en route for the show. DOMINANT CURRENCY had a good finish down the outside of the course. COSSET four wide at the half mile pole, reached the quarter pole holding a good striking position, made a run for the lead from the head of the stretch to the furlong marker before flattening out. TALE UNTOLD three wide and between rivals on the turn, lacked the needed response. STORM SHOWERS took the overland route and had no rally. VICTORIA LYNN disputed the pace from the two path until upper stretch and folded. LET'S GET FISCAL argued the pace from the inside for a half before faltering.
