Footnotes

MIDNIGHT WATCH shot of the starting gate and using her long strides powered her way to the front, kicked away from the others well before the initial split was recorded, took up in resistance in the two path cutting the pace on an open lead, pulling slightly on the bit but otherwise rating kindly, spun into the stretch still comfortably well out in front and had the pilot switch over to a drive, displayed some greenness during the opening phases of the stretch run by bearing out slightly, was taken back towards the inside thereafter, with the use of some right handed stick work and strong pressure on the left rein, dug in with good determination to hold sway. WALTZING CAT between opponents during the run around the second bend, was taken inward after entering the stretch, finished willingly to procure the place. WHITE ROSE three wide on the far turn, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild response to secure the show. GRENOBLE took the inside route, picked up interest momentarily midway on the second turn, got outfinished. TABREED (GB) hit the left side of the starting gate, went onward for a few strides then bobbled after appearing to take a bad step, saved ground for most of the opening three-quarters, swung four wide into upper stretch, got straightened away and mainly went on to improve position. EDDY GOURMET rank fighting noticeably on the bit during the very earliest stages, raced three wide on both turns, failed to have an impact. SOUTH SHORE gave chase from off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, had no rally. VERY PLAYFUL raced towards the inside to no avail.
