Footnotes

PICO CENTRAL (BRZ) bobbled at the start, raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, responded when roused in upper stretch, drew clear inside the eighth pole then dug in gamely and held off BOWMAN'S BAND under strong handling. BOWMAN'S BAND was urged along inside, was in tight quarters on the rail on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished fast from the outside. STRONG HOPE quickly showed in front, set the pace under pressure from the winner, could not stay with that rival leaving the eighth pole and weakened in deep stretch. GYGISTAR was unhurried outside early, put in a four wide run on the turn and faded in the final furlong. FUNNY CIDE raced close up while between rivals three wide and had no response when roused. SAARLAND was outrun early, advanced four wide on the turn, came widest into the stretch and was no real threat with a mild rally outside. EYE OF THE TIGER raced in hand while between rivals early, angled out and rallied four wide approaching the stretch and had nothing left for the drive. AZERI raced close up inside while in hand and came up empty when called on. MOBIL was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused.
