**Footnotes**

MICHELE THE GREAT raced close up early, rallied three wide, drew clear when roused and was kept to a drive to the finish. WHATEVERWILLBWillb raced close up early, rallied inside into the stretch and was outfinished. SQUARE DANCING was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the turn and had little left for the stretch drive. APPEALING MYSTERY was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and was going well late outside. CLASSIC EXPRESSION had no rally. FLIGHTTOHEPELICAN set the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters. ACCREDITING had no rally. CLASSIC MARILYN pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. FIDDLERS PLEASURE was outrun along the inside.
