Footnotes

SAMHOON away from the gate in good order, battled for the lead along the inside, began to edge clear midway on the turn, was set down turning for home and drew off during the stretch drive under a drive. TIZWAY bumped at the start, vied three wide for the lead, couldn't keep pace with the top one nearing the stretch but continued on with good courage to be well clear for the place. LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH saved ground, was swung three wide into the stretch and improved his position to be a non-threatening third. PLAN was squeezed back after being bumped both sides at the start, raced along the outside, was fanned four wide, lacked a solid closing response. I. M. BOOMER forwardly placed four wide until the quarter pole, tired. LONELY HIGHWAY rank while racing along the inside, was taken out of harm's way to the three path during the run down the backstretch, continued acting rank around the turn and was eased in the stretch. IZANAGI was bumped at the start, vied between rivals for the lead for a half and faltered.
