COACH GRAVY pressed the pace in hand from outside, took the lead while drifting wide at the quarter pole, maintained a clear advantage while drifting out in deep stretch and was fully extending to hold on while tiring in the late stages. LION'S LAIR saved ground the entire way and closed mildly but wasn't quite good enough. ALWAYS ON THE MOVE chased three wide for a half and finished evenly. DONTQUITYOURDAYJOB trailed after a slow start, circled six wide and improved his position while passing tiring horses. KING BO BO failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. TRIPLE GLORY was never a factor. DUNVEGAN battled inside the winner to the turn and gave way.
