### Footnotes

DRIVEN BY SUCCESS lunged in the air at the start, moved up from outside, made a four wide move to challenge on the turn, took charge entering the stretch then drew off while drifting out under left hand urging through the final eighth. SPEIGHT OF HAND raced up close between horses, rallied three wide to challenge midway on the turn, gained a brief lead nearing the quarter pole but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. JACK ON THE ROCKS led early after an alert start, battled along the rail, reclaimed the lead along the rail briefly on the turn, angled out while dropping back in upper stretch and failed to threaten thereafter. RETRIEVER never reached contention. MAJESTIC BLUE was hard held early, rushed to the front between horses, surrendered the lead midway on the turn and steadied while giving way near the quarter pole.
