WILD AWAKE was well placed just off the pace for a half, saved ground through the turn, closed the gap along the fence in midstretch, fought gamely into deep stretch and narrowly won the nod at the wire. WHO IS LADY was under a firm hold along the backstretch, rallied three wide on the turn, opened a clear advantage in midstretch, battled between horses into deep stretch and lost the bob. JUSTIFY was well in hand for a half, steadied in traffic on the turn, swung five wide then closed steadily in the middle of the track to just miss in a tight finish. A WORD TO THE WISE pressed the pace in the two path, steadied sharply between horses in upper stretch and failed to threaten thereafter. SUNNY was outrun to the turn, angled out and close late in the middle of the track. GLORY IN MOTION set a pressured pace on the rail and tired. CAP THE THUNDER raced wide throughout and lacked a late response. ALLTHESINGLELADYS steadied early and was never close thereafter.
