CHECK THE LABEL settled in good position along the rail, raced just off the pace while saving ground midway on the turn, waited just behind the leaders nearing the quarter pole, angled out a bit entering the stretch, steadied briefly in traffic in upper stretch, split horses for running room to challenge a furlong out then edged clear under good handling. CRESCENDA steadied after being pinched back at the start, trailed along the backstretch, steadied along the rail at the half mile pole, moved out on the far turn, circled five wide into the stretch then finished well in the middle of the track to gain the place. NEGLIGEE stalked the pace from outside for seven furlongs, launched a bid four wide at the quarter pole, drew on even terms for the lead in midstretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. KHANCORD KID steadied in traffic soon after the start, was unhurried in hand on the backstretch, launched a move three wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. MORE IS BETTER was bumped at the start, pressed the pace in hand from outside to the turn, split horses to gain a brief lead in midstretch then faltered in the final eighth. HIT IT RICH bumped at the start, was rated between horses for six furlongs, raced just behind the leaders to the turn, steadied while blocked behind a wall of horses entering the stretch, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing response. ULTIMATE CLASS broke outward at the start, took the early lead along the rail, set a pressured pace to the turn and gave way.
