Footnotes

BAD DEBT sat well within range while racing three wide around both turns, crept up towards the front runners during the later stages of the run around the far turn, spun into the stretch and got turned loose, made up good ground during the initial portion of the stretch drive, continued onward chopping away at the leader's margin little by little, collared that opponent right at the wire to wrest away the decision. LIGHTHOUSE SOUND made a three wide run on the first turn to secure the lead, was swung over to the inside after having done so, cut the pace, under a good hold from the pilot, maintained the same advantage over the closest pursuer upon departing the backstretch, even though that foe was set down to a drive by the midway point, entered the stretch and was switched over to a drive himself, showed good determination but got caught in the last jump. RED LEADER was coaxed along prompting the pacesetter from the outside down the backstretch, was asked for a bit more and more proceeding his way on the far turn until put a drive by the three-eighths pole, held on for the show. TAWAARED was put to a snug hold after leaving the starting gate, offered some resistance on the bit for most of the way around the opening bend, entered the backstretch and proved more ratable thereafter, contently tracked the front runners from the pocket, got called upon at the head of the stretch, was partially alongside the runner up when taken in hand momentarily when the rail passageway being utilized at this juncture tightened up just a notch, this occurring in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, recovered quickly and showed some willingness, but had to settle for the last major check. PERFECT FOOTPRINT bobbed at the start, sat reserved from off the inside for nearly three-quarters, lost out on the two path at the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home under a full drive, got out finished. INDY SCENT slipped off the rail late on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, had no rally.
