

FULLY LIVING got hooked up in a speed duel with CAN'T EXPLAIN nearly from the get-go, raced as a team with that opponent, with the riders of both asking their mounts for some run, but with neither being fully extended either, fell back slightly as the pair neared the head of the stretch, got asked for her best after setting into upper stretch, staged a comeback to re gain command leaving the furlong grounds, dug in with good determination to preserve the decision, kept to a drive. CAN'T EXPLAIN away well, responded to some hand urging to advance into a forward position, sparred with the top one in a spirited tussle while racing along the outside, kept to some encouragement throughout it all, edged away late on the turn and got turned loose, wasn't able to shake free, reached the eighth pole back on nearly even terms with the winner, fell back slightly soon afterwards and had to settle for being second best. KANSAS stumbled badly at the break, raced from off the inside on the turn, under some urging for most of the way around it, took the three path into the stretch, proved no match for the top pair. VALUE IN MOTION underwent a inside journey, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, faltered nonetheless. LUVMEALLDAYINDYUSA stumbled badly at the start, resulting in the rider losing both irons, proceeded as the lone trailer as the pilot attempted to rectify the situation, was back in both of them by midstretch, then completed the race under a brisk hand ride.
