FOX RULES away alertly, showed the way just off the inside under a light grip from the two path, was unhurried until nearing the head of the lane when his closest pursuers got busy, was set down turning for home, lost the lead briefly coming to the eighth pole, battled back inside with good determination to come again, took over nearing the finish and began to inch away late on to prevail. FOURSEVENTEEN placed three wide in close range of the front, came under encouragement to close in from the five-sixteenths, swung for home on nearly even terms with the leader, battled through the lane seizing command nearing the final furlong, fought on readily through to the wire, was displaced in the final few jumps while just holding the place honors over a fast closing rail threat. GIMME CREDIT reserved just off the pace in behind the leader and behind cover, was set down at the quarter pole, found a clear lane inside, rallied with good late energy to just miss the place honors while safe for the show. DECIPHERING DREAMS was urged from the gate to be forwardly placed, came under a firm hold to track the pace while two to three wide, sat unhurried until the five-sixteenths pole, was let out at that station, vied between rivals briefly from there until the head of the stretch, ran on being out kicked in the final furlong by the top three while safe for the last major share. MAJESTIC RAFFY sat in midpack well rated until midway on the turn, ranged up into contention four wide under urging, couldn't sustain the move after swinging four to five wide for home and flattened out late on. STORMY SUCCESS unhurried at the rear, chased two to three wide through the turn, was pushed along from the three-eighths pole and passed tired rivals in the lane. SKY MUSIC raced between rivals towards the rear while two deep, swung two to three wide in upper

stretch and made no late headway. TUG OF WAR chased three wide in midpack, came under urging midway on the turn, swung four wide in upper stretch and weakened in the lane. QUIET FAVORITE reserved off the pace, saved ground throughout, cut the corner into the lane offering no kick.
