Footnotes

IMAGINING patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, closed the gap upon reaching the far turn, turned for home, was given his cue and took off in earnest, wrested away the lead before reaching the furlong marker, kicked clear, kept to a drive. CHANGE OF COMMAND established control before reaching the backstretch, showed the way from the inside on a loosely-contested lead, felt the top one's presence departing the half mile pole, got called upon entering the stretch, fell back slightly during the ensuing furlong, continued onward willingly but had to settle for the place. FIZZANO saved ground and proved no match. COEXIST was taken hold several times after leaving the starting gate and was soon the trailer, saved ground until upper stretch, lacked the necessary response. LISTON raced along the outside and had no rally. KING TING (IRE) three wide around both turns, was let out a notch in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, failed to pick up the pace and folded.
