GIULIO'S JEWEL assumed the role of primary pursuer soon after the start, crept up towards the pacesetter during the later stages of run around the bend, challenged that rival as the pair spun into the stretch on nearly even terms, took over and gradually edged away making her way to the eighth pole, was put to brisker handling departing that station and kicked away. SO ROYAL established control shortly after the start, was sent over to the inside before reaching the end of the backstretch, had the top one increase her presence late on the turn, was put to a drive prior to cutting the corner into the stretch clinging to a bare advantage, yielded before completing the next furlong, continued on willingly to remain well clear of the others for the place. MIGHTY REWARD chased the top twosome from off the inside, commenced the stretch three wide, proved no match. RETTALFA got away awkwardly, lunging at the break, was sent over to the rail and rode it until the five-sixteenths pole, paused in hand then slipped outward, swung wider and wider until in the four path at the head of the stretch, lacked the necessary response. IVANOVNA placed along the inside route coming to the half mile pole, had no rally. DADDY'S BIG GIRL underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, gave way. MISS MCKEOWN off to a sluggish beginning, raced from off the inside and failed to menace. TIZ NOTORIOUS was taken hold of after veering inward at the start, offered little off the subsequent ground-saving journey. BOUNTY PINK lost her action less than a furlong into the event, lost contact rapidly, was under a protective hold nearing the quarter pole, got eased, then pulled up before being vanned off.
