### Footnotes

ANAPHYLAXIS coaxed along to be forwardly placed, dueled from the inside with CALL FOR THE CLOCK, got headed and set down cutting the corner into the stretch, dug in fighting on along the rail coming again to get up and prevail on the line. COPPER FOREST just off the pace just off the inside, shifted to the three path at the seven-sixteenths, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, took command swinging three wide for home, dug in safe to the eighth pole, battled on with a pair through the final furlong and just held on at the wire. JUNIOR OFFICER three wide in mid pack early on, commenced a three wide bid from the half mile pole improving position to be four wide at the three-eighths as COPPER FOREST shifted out, continued four wide into upper stretch, kicked on with good energy the outermost of a trio through the final eighth and just missed. CALL FOR THE CLOCK dueled two to three wide with ANAPHYLAXIS, got set down at the five-sixteenths, was shaken off a bit at the quarter pole spinning just off the inside into the lane now in behind rivals, angled out to the four path at the three-sixteenths, rallied with a mild kick for the last major share. WARRIOR UP broke in at the start bumping MODERN CHILD and squeezing that foe back at the start, settled two to three wide towards the rear, shifted four wide three furlongs out, commenced a drive at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild belated bid while unable to make an impact. PAPA TOM stumbled at the start, tracked inside within aim of the front, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide for home and weakened. COALITION broke out at the start, bumping MODERN CHILD and squeezing that foe back in tandem with WARRIOR UP, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under a drive swinging four wide in upper stretch and offered no rally. MODERN CHILD jostled between foes and squeezed back at the start, saved ground towards

the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths fading from striking range then was eased through the final furlong.
