FICKLE FRIENDS raced close up inside while in hand, split rivals in midstretch and drew clear under a drive. ENTER pressed the pace from the outside and stayed on gamely to the finish. SIDE SADDLE (IRE) was rated along between rivals, rallied four wide nearing the stretch and lacked a solid closing kick. MARIQUITA'S SECRET broke slowly, was outrun early, put in a five wide run into the stretch and stayed on well to the finish. SOLO ROLO raced inside and lacked a rally. LADY CRYSTAL raced three wide and tired. TAKE THREE set the pace and tired in the stretch. CRITICAL EYE had no response when roused.
