Footnotes

UNACCOUNTABLE sat reserved in midpack towards the inside under a good hold, was eased into the two path just past the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home and got called upon, squeezed his way between rivals in upper stretch, remained wedged between them before kicking free and ducking over to the rail in mid lane, rallied to scoot by the front runners and edge away. VEILED PROPHET vacated the rail midway on the full turn, came home with good energy to procure the place. FREE BRAVE three wide into the backstretch, worked out a tuck into the two path in time for the run around the far turn, picked up interest approaching the quarter pole, although lacking optimal clearance, sought access to the outside after settling in upper stretch but had those plans stymied, with any potential escape route blocked at this juncture, went on a little further, had clearance by now and tipped into the five path in the vicinity of the eighth pole, finished well belatedly to secure the show. XODO strung out three wide on the elbow chute, remained well off the inside throughout, scampered into contention with a four wide run on the far turn, but could not sustain the move after turning for home. BERNIE THE MAESTRO stalked the pacesetter from the outside, moved when ready to take over at the five-sixteenths pole, and got turned loose soon afterwards, arrived at the eighth pole still

in front but with others in hot pursuit, relinquished to the pressure about a sixteenth later and steadily weakened. KID CURRY well placed for six furlongs, lacked the needed response. TRUE LINNET was no menace. BOLD VINDICATION underwent a three wide journey, was briefly in hand off heels when XODO went by sailing by late on the second turn, folded. PARKINSON FIELD rated along the inside, laying down moderate opening splits on a loosely-contested lead, got overwhelmed at the five-sixteenths marker. and retreated. EL MARTILLO saved ground to no avail.
