Footnotes

PURE AMOUR bumped with some impact at the break, settled along the rail, contently tracked the front runners for the initial stages, picked up the pace, as did most of the competition upon entering the far turn, appeared eager closing in on the rival directly up ahead past the midway point, that being BELONGS TO DIXIE, steadied, settled back into proper stride soon afterwards and angled sharply three wide into the stretch, took off after the leader and closed in with gusto, drew on dead even terms a shot distance past the eighth pole, took over for good after a spirited, but abbreviated duel and kicked away. MOONLIT SONNET bumped soundly at the start, lost her best action and fell back steadily until only in front of one as the first fraction was being recorded, remained well reserved down the backstretch, matched into contention primarily two wide during the run around the second bend, paused then angled outward and drafted behind the winner into the stretch, tipped to that rival's outside after going down the road a bit more, closed in with good late energy to procure the place. EUROKAY BY ME sat forwardly placed, three wide until the half mile pole, ranged up towards the leader after going halfway around the far turn, was let out and after issuing a challenge took over and worked her way to a clear advantage deep into the furlong grounds, had the winner draw abreast leaving the eighth pole, offered resistance before yielding, held on well thereafter for the show. HEART OF NEW YORK sluggish proceeding on the first turn after breaking out slightly, loped along for the opening half, was put to some mild hand urging and picked up interest departing the backstretch, swung three to four wide into the stretch and came home with good belated energy to grab the last major check. CHLOE BEAR off the inside, lacked the necessary stretch response. BELONGS TO DIXIE dragged into the pocket by the pilot with considerable effort coming to the half mile pole, came up empty. RED CODE placed five wide at the head of the stretch, made no headway. GET GORGEOUS bumped soundly between rivals at the start, was three wide midway on the far turn and six wide by upper stretch, failed to have an impact. KATIE MALONE quickly established control, was under a snug hold setting the opening splits, came under pressure after completing three-quarters, yielded to it and retreated.
