FOR THREE YEAR OLDS FOALD IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. No nomination fee. \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$650 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse will be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs.

Non-winners of \$50,000 in 2013 allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. A bonus of \$250,000 to the owner of the same horse that wins all three legs of the Big Apple Triple (The Mike Lee, The New York Derby and The Albany) providing a MINIMUM of SIX (6) horses start out of the gate. Footnotes

AMBERJACK sat reserved from the two path off the front runners, angled out three wide entering the stretch, rallied from between rivals for a good portion of the run through the furlong grounds, drew even with the second place finisher in the vicinity of the sixteenths pole, took over after sparring head to head with that foe for a few strides and kicked away in the final seventy yards. WEEKEND HIDEAWAY came away in good order, hooked up and raced as a team with HAY SHARES, with the rider of both attempting to hold something in reserve throughout the initial half and slightly beyond that, took over leaving the five-sixteenths pole, still travelling under his own power and turned for home holding about a length advantage, got set down, had the winner draw abreast with a sixteenth to go, fell back slightly after offering some resistance, continued on gamely to secure second. SMOOTH BERT kept watch on the embattled duo, put to some hand urging and parked out in the three path, lost some position to the top one entering the stretch, lacked the needed closing response. SOUL HOUSE was quickly sent onto the inside route, rode the rail to almost the quarter pole, was under urging swinging three wide into the stretch, made no headway. WEST HILLS GIANT stumbled badly at the start, falling three lengths behind the others in a flash, was put to some light hand urging and rejoined the pack, raced three wide on the turn, at times loosely drafting behind SMOOTH BERT, entered the stretch and gave way. HAY SHARES, stumbled at the start, contested the pace at or near the rail for the opening half, under a good hold by the pilot, got shaken off by the nemesis nearing the quarter pole and faltered. RUN RUN FORREST four wide midway on the turn, folded.
