KING KREESA on the pace lightly coaxed from just off the inside, remained patiently handled until the pressure intensified nearing the quarter pole, got set down at that station, dug in repulsing a trio to the eighth pole, had the rider pull on the near side rein to tighten up the lane inside a sixteenth out forcing the rallying KHARAFa to pause briefly and alter course, then inched away in the late stages to prevail. KHARAFa tracked the pace along the inside within aim of the front, cut the corner roused into the stretch, rallied up the rail into contention a furlong out, had the leader shift over to tighten up the rail, was forced to steady briefly and alter course a sixteenth out losing momentum as a result while finishing with good energy nonetheless for the place. LUBASH keen early on just off the pace two to three wide, remained behind cover unsettled to the three-eighths, got asked at the five-sixteenths, swung out four wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show. STREET GAME three wide in close range in pursuit in hand, took closer order three furlongs out, continued three wide roused into upper stretch offering up a mild kick through to the wire while being out kicked by the top trio. ABILIO well rated saving ground in mid pack, angled three wide in upper stretch let out for the drive, rallied mildly but was out kicked through the stretch. SNEAKY KITTEN three wide towards the rear in hand until the five-sixteenths when set down made no late headway. LIGHTNING STONE just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and offered no response. MINNIE PUNT four wide throughout, made a mild bid into the far turn to improve position to the three-eighths, faded a bit in the latter part of the turn, continued four wide for home and weakened.
