SPLASHY WOLF was outrun early, raced three wide and had no rally. CECILIA'S GIRL had no rally. COUNT THE STARS contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. CUPASOUP chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. JUAN'S IVANA tired after showing brief speed.
