PREFERRED OPTION quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace while in hand, responded when roused in the stretch and remained clear, driving. MONTANA CAT was unhurried early on, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. WON MORO chased the pace along the inside and lacked a rally. ALPINE PASS was rated inside, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. TEXTBOOK METHOD chased the pace while four wide and tired in the stretch. ROYAL BANQUET chased the pace while between rivals and tired. DANDY DULCE was outrun.
