DISTORTED LEGACY contently rode the rail, began to advance under some hand encouragement from the half mile pole, had plenty of room to ease outward on the turn, was driven three wide into the stretch and took off in earnest after the front runner, reached that one's hind quarters right at the sixteenth pole, went by during the next seventy yards and kicked clear under a drive. CODY SAMORA got off to a sharp beginning and angled sharply towards the inside, set the pace on an open lead under a good hold from the rider, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, was roused coming to the three-sixteenths pole, emerged from the furlong grounds, still in possession of a comfortable advantage, but not for too long, as the top one closed in more readily, felt that one's presence with a sixteenth remaining, held out as long as possible before yielding the front, but continued onward willingly to secure second. ALL ABOUT ALEX loosely tracked the pacesetter down the backstretch, made up ground steadily during the run around the bend, but could not sustain the bid after entering the stretch. ISLAND SCHOOL three wide departing the backstretch, ducked over to the inside coming to the five-sixteenths pole, with paths one through four filled with other opponents at that juncture, cut the corner into the stretch under encouragement but lacked a solid closing punch. LIFE'S MEASURE asked for some run midway on the turn, came four wide into the stretch under much stronger handling and tired.
